Canal Tour of Copenhagen by Boat



Dates: Every day, between 9.30 am and 6.00 pm
(every 15-30 minutes)

Duration: Approximately 1 hour

Meeting Point: Nyhavn (close to Kongens Nytorv)

The canal boat will take you to all the sights situated along the canals of Copenhagen.

Hamlet Tour



Dates: Every day at 10.30 am

Duration: Approximately 6 hours, 30 minutes

Price: €100 per person

The tour is a great way of seeing the castles and the countryside north of Copenhagen. Kronborg Castle, known as Elsinore in English, stands at the seaward approach to the Øresund Sound.

It's one of northern Europe's best preserved Renaissance castles. Made famous all over the world by Shakespeare's Hamlet, it is also the most popular castle in Denmark, with about 200,000 visitors each year.

After Kronborg Castle the tour continues past Fredensborg Castle, where you have time to explore the castle. This castle has for years and years been the Royal Couple's most used summer residence, and for a period of time the main residence of HRH Crown Prince Frederik and HRH Crown Princess Mary.

After the photo stop at Fredensborg Castle you will have 1h 30 min to enjoy the magnificent surroundings of Frederiksborg

Castle located in Hillerød. The Castle Gardens include an English style romantic garden and a more formal French baroque garden, recreated in 1996, to replicate J.C. Krieger's gardens from 1725.

Included on the tour:

Kronborg Castle Entrance, time at attraction 1h 30 min

Frederiksborg Castle (outside), time at the castle 1h 30 min.

Beautiful drive along a scenic coast line.

Castle Combo Tour



Dates: Every day at 10.30 am

Duration: Approximately 6 hours, 30 minutes

The tour is a great way of seeing the castles and countryside north of Copenhagen. We leave Copenhagen and travel up the Riviera road to Helsingør. As we travel along we have a beautiful view of the Øresund Strait with the Swedish coast beyond.

Get the best out of a day in beautiful North Sealand and visit all the Castles on the route. Go inside and experience the Dungeons of Kronborg and later that day the wonders of Frederiksborg Castle. Both these ancient castles only available together with the Castle Tour ticket.

Entré Hamlet

We drive to Elsinore where we will go inside and experience the impressive Kronborg Castle, the setting of Shakespeare's play "Hamlet". The castle was built between 1574-1585 to protect Danish interests and to collect tolls from ships passing through the narrow strait.

After Kronborg Castle the tour continues past the Royal Family's summer residence, Fredensborg Castle. This palace has for years

and years been the Royal Couple's most used summer residence, and for a period of time the main residence of HRH Crown Prince Frederik and HRH Crown Princess Mary.

Entré Frederiksborg

After the photo stop at Fredensborg Castle, you will experience the inside of the magnificent Frederiksborg Castle located in Hillerød. The visit includes the National History Museum's royal art collection, the Chapel of Orders and the Knight's Hall.
